- Awareness: BGC wants to make organizations, the general public, and golfers across Canada more aware of blind golf, and the blind individuals, their coaches and volunteers that make it happen. We care and are asking for help from philanthropists across Canada to help BGC, help others.
- **Grow the Sport**: Where there is a need, there is BGC. There are an estimated 1.5 million blind and visually impaired people across Canada. Many of you reading this know people who are blind and families with blind persons. BGC hopes that you will help us get more of the blind community to come out, and that you will come out and see what the sport means to blind golfers.
- **Support/Stability**: This is all about scale, and helping BGC sponsor events, and support the blind golf community on a regional basis. As a not-for-profit group, that is currently applying for our Canadian charitable status, we know how important it is to make sure we are in a position to keep doing what we can for the sport in Canada. BGC is hosting the World Blind Golf Championships in 2025, and in 2024 we have our Canadian Blind Golf Championships and Western Canadian Championships being held in beautiful British Columbia.

BGC, is all about serving an underrepresented segment of the Canadian public. Persons with disabilities that are too often forgotten. Now more than ever BGC needs help. With COVID, our membership plummeted. Understandably so. Today, we need to get our membership, and our accounts back to pre-COVID levels. That would be a difference maker in so many ways.

BGC knows that a lot of persons with disabilities struggle financially. 62% of blind persons are not employed, and for the 38% that do have an income, on average it is 45% less than the pre-tax median income of the average Canadian. That is a harsh reality. Canadians with disabilities know these figures too well. It is the reason why our goal as a charity will be to continue subsidizing the events to the best of our abilities. Without us, and supporters like you, or enterprises and businesses, blind golfers don't, or can't, come out and take part in an incredible experience.

The importance of these events can't be understated. The ability to lobby governments and organizations to impact real change in the blind golf and blind sports community can't be understated. BGC wants to have a longer-term relationship with benefactors and partners, and we are open to discussing all options. #### **Interesting Blind Golf Facts & Goals**

- Blind golf has been "around" since the 1950's, and BGC has been part of that journey for over 10+ years. We are now entering a new era, a second decade of excellence. We could not be prouder.
- Blind golf follows all of the traditional rules of golf, except the golfer plays with a Coach, who helps him or her set-up on the tee, or address the ball, and lines them up. Without a Coach there is no blind golf. Same applies to our volunteer Board, and all of the volunteers that make each of the events special.
- There are 3 sight categories that were established by the IBGA (International Blind Golf Association) in the late 1990's. Ranging from the ever-inspirational B1 blind golfer with 0% vision, B2 blind golfers with 0-5% of their vision, and B3 blind golfers with 5-10% of their vision.
- Each BGC member pays a nominal membership fee to their provincial organization, and those organizations forward dues to BGC. Thanks to a relationship with Golf Canada, BGC members also get membership status, and access to game and handicapping software with Golf Canada.
- This is not just a numbers game, in fact, if anything it is about experiences and the magic that happens when persons with disabilities experience the joy and awe of sport.
- BGC is about promoting integrity and sportsmanship, socialization and relationship building, helping our members and the blind community have the confidence, and perseverance to keep the dream alive. We have competitive, and recreational divisions and opportunities.
- BGC supports, partially subsidizes, and sends our best blind golfers to American and international competitions. BGC intends for the World Blind Golf Championships in 2025 to also include a recreational division for the first time ever.
- Our focus in the 2024/2025 seasons will be on increasing the number of our women golfers who are blind, and youth aged 13-30 who are blind. These are demographics BGC will gladly serve, and our numbers must become more representative of the blind community at large, across Canada.
- BGC is trying to secure long-term stake holders to support the growth and sustainability of blind golf in Canada. Please share and help us shine a light of blind golf awareness.
